



WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Friday, March 25, 2011 to Sunday, March 27, 2011

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

East 59th Street between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue: This street will be closed from 7am to 4pm Saturday to facilitate NYCDDC trunk water main and utility work. Motorists should use alternate routes and posted detours to access Queensboro Bridge such as 2nd Avenue southbound or East 58th Street eastbound onto the Second Avenue contra flow lane.

West Street (9A) Southbound between Canal Street and Watts Street: Two of three southbound lanes may be closed Sunday to Friday 11pm to 5am, 11pm Friday to 10am Saturday and 11pm Saturday to 10am Sunday to facilitate NYPD lane closure activity from January 31 to April 30, 2011.

West Street (9A) between Liberty Street and Albany Street: Two of three lanes in one direction at a time may be closed 11pm to 5am Monday to Friday, 1am to 7am Saturday, and 2am to 9am Sunday to facilitate NYPD lane closure activity from January 31 to April 30, 2011.

FDR Drive between Grand Street and Montgomery Street; also vicinity of East 103rd Street: One of three lanes will be closed in each direction Sunday from 1am to 2am and again from 7am to 11am, and two of three lanes will be closed in each direction Sunday from 2am to 7am to facilitate bridge inspection.

8th Avenue between West 31st Street and West 33rd Street: Three lanes of traffic will be maintained Saturday and/or Sunday from 12:01am to 10am to facilitate crane operation.

West 16th Street between 9th Avenue and 8th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 7am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 18th Street between Broadway and Park Avenue South: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 25th Street between Park Avenue South and Lexington Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 30th Street between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 32nd Street between Broadway and 5th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 39th Street between 6th Avenue and 5th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 40th Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 45th Street between Lexington Avenue and Madison Avenue; Vanderbilt Avenue between East 44th Street and East 46th Street; Park Avenue viaduct southbound between East 46th Street and East 42nd Street; Vanderbilt Avenue northbound only between East 43rd Street and East 44th Street: These streets will be closed from 7am Saturday to 5am Monday to facilitate MTA East Side Access structural work.

West 50th Street between 10th Avenue and 11th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 51st Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 56th Street between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 9pm to facilitate crane removal operation.

East 56th Street between Lexington Avenue and Park Avenue: This street will be closed Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 66th Street between Columbus Avenue and Central Park West: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Spring Street between 6th Avenue and Sullivan Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 5pm to facilitate crane operation.

Bedford Street between Grove Street and Barrow Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

Elk Street between Reade Street and Duane Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

William Street between John Street and Fulton Street: This street will be closed 8pm Friday to 6am Saturday and 8pm Saturday to 6am Sunday overnight only to facilitate MTA/Fulton Transit Center work.

Cedar Street between Broadway and Trinity Place: This street will be closed Saturday and Sunday from 10am to 10pm to facilitate Con Ed utility work.

Cliff Street between John Street and Fulton Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate NYCDDC roadway work.

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 12PM Noon to 2PM for the Persian Iranian Parade as permitted by NYPD.

5th Avenue between 65th Street and 64th Street

Route:

5th Avenue between 79th Street and 65th Street

Dispersal:

Central Park South between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 1:30PM to 4:30PM for the Federation of Hellenic Societies of Greater NY Parade as permitted by NYPD.

Formation:

51st Street between 5th Avenue and Madison Avenue

Route:

51st Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue

5th Avenue between 50th Street and 51st Street

Dispersal:

Included within formation

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 1:45PM to 5PM for the Auxiliary Police Benevolent Association NY Parade as permitted by NYPD.

Route:

Broadway between 34th Street and 35th Street (Pedestrian Plaza)

34th Street between Broadway and 7th Avenue (Curb Lane Only)

35th Street between Broadway and 7th Avenue (Curb Lane Only)

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 11AM to 8:30PM for the 37th Annual Macy's Flower Show as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

MANHATTAN/BROOKLYN

Williamsburg Bridge: The North Outer Roadway will be closed Saturdays (rain date Sundays) from 5am to 6pm March 26, April 2, and April 9. During these closures there will be four lanes maintained westbound to Manhattan (no trucks), and two lanes maintained eastbound to Brooklyn. Truck traffic should follow posted detour and use Manhattan Bridge.

BROOKLYN

Gowanus Expressway Outbound/Southbound Exit Ramp to the Prospect Expressway: This ramp will be closed 12:01am to 7am Saturday to facilitate NYSDOT construction activity.

Remsen Street between Clinton Street and Court Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 7am to 7pm to facilitate crane operation.

Belt Parkway eastbound between Flatbush Avenue and Mill Basin Bridge: A full closure will occur 12:01am to 5am Tuesday to Friday, and 12:01am to 7am Saturday from March 21 to 26, 2011 to facilitate NYCDOT roadway milling and resurfacing. Motorists should use alternate or follow posted detour.

BRONX

Hughes Avenue between East Tremont Avenue and East 178th Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 9am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

QUEENS

Rockaway Freeway between Beach 87th Street and Beach 88th Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

95th Street between Jamaica Avenue and 89th Avenue: This street will be closed 8pm Friday to 9pm Monday to facilitate NYCT crane operation.

97th Street between Jamaica Avenue and 89th Avenue: This street will be closed 8pm Friday to 9pm Monday to facilitate NYCT crane operation.

Jamaica Avenue between 89th Avenue and 95th Avenue: One lane in each direction will be maintained 8pm Friday to 5am Monday to facilitate NYCT overhead track replacement.

Honeywell Street Bridge between 39th Avenue and 37th Avenue: This street will be closed from 10pm to 5am Friday night into Saturday morning and Saturday night into Sunday morning to facilitate MTA construction activity work.
